Updated Amendments to RIVER VISTA by-laws

3 of the 5 proposed new amendments passed during our annual meeting.

The updates to our governing documents will be published on the website within next few months.

The new amendments are:

- Building heights within River Vista are limited to two (2) stories and no more than 35 feet.
- Guest houses, apartments, detached mother-in-law suites and similar structures are prohibited.
- 3) The Association funds can be deposited in US bank accounts, money market funds, certificates of deposit, securities and other similar investment accounts.

MPORTANT: March meeting

topic: Sealing River Vista private Roads

The board has been working on getting estimates and proposals to reseal our private roads. Repaving roads are quite costly, and fortunately ours are not yet in need to do so. By sealing, we may be able to extend the road lifespan by 5 to 8 years.

The Board of Directors will vote at the next meeting to approve or disapprove the work. We encourage everyone to come to the meeting if they have any concerns or questions. If resealing is approved, we estimate to have the work done before summer. Two thin coats of tar will be sprayed. The roads would be done one side at a time so parking should be done in the swale near your property. The process will take approximatively 3 days and residents will not be able to drive on the roads for 48 hours. It is advised to drive slowly onto your driveway in the following 36 hours as to avoid marks.

Notice will be sent by email to alert residents of road closing schedule. We will try our best to limit the inconvenience due to the work
